The focus will be on drawing from observation starting with graphite pencils (day 1) and moving to watercolour (day 2) to achieve realistic renderings of botanical subjects. This will incorporate developing skills such as tonal variation, different mark making techniques, understanding how basic geometric shapes can be found in nature and translating them into your painting. This workshop is suitable for beginners with little to no experience in botanical art and is presented in a friendly and supportive environment within the setting of the beautiful Geelong Botanic Gardens.
