This will incorporate developing skills such as tonal variation, different mark making techniques, understanding how basic geometric shapes can be found in nature and translating them into your drawings. Suitable for beginners with little to no experience and is presented in a friendly and supportive environment at the beautiful Geelong Botanic Gardens.
